**WOMEN IN THE BIBLE SYLLABUS**

**Course Description:**

While male characters have played a central role in the action and narratives of the bible, women have also been depicted in powerful and transformative ways in stories that tend to be overlooked or downplayed. In this course, we are exploring powerful women characters in the narratives from the Hebrew scriptures and the Christian scriptures and applying their stories to all of our spiritual lives, beyond gender. This class will also be a practice in biblical metaphysics interpretation for newcomers as well as experienced metaphysical students.

**Course Learning Objectives:**

By the end of the course, learners will be able to:

- Name and identify female characters in the scriptures that denote aspects of our spiritual life and teach a truth through the narrative that can be applied to their own lives.
- Use the stories as tools for practicing metaphysical interpretation of the scriptures and identifying spiritual principles that can be applied to their lives or situations they find in the world today.
- Discern how the historical, social, literal and metaphysical aspects of a story contribute to enriching their understanding of the value of the scriptures in their lives today.
